Class Descriptions:

- **Young Entry / Rusty Stirrup** is for non-professional riders. Classes will be split by age, (12 and under & 13 and up) if 10 or more entries. Riders will trot into the line over a Xrail and canter out over an 18" vertical.
- **Limit Equitation** open to non-professional riders. Course is to be ridden at a canter.
- **Mini Hunter, Low Hunter, Schooling Hunter, Open Hunter, and Modified Hunter** are open to all ponies, horses and riders.
- **Equitation Medal 2' and 2'6** are open to non-professional riders. This class will consist of two phases. Top 8 riders will be invited back for 2nd flat phase. O/F will count 75%, flat will count 25%.
- **HG Equitation Flat Challenge** is open to non-professional riders. Riders will be asked to perform any of the USEF Equitation tests 1-19
- **Pre-Beginner** is for riders 12 and under in their first or second year of showing. Riders may cross enter into Beginner Ground Poles.
- **Beginner Ground Rails** is for riders 12 and under in their first two years of showing. Riders may cross enter in Pre-Beginner OR Beginner X's but not both.
- **Beginner X's** is open to riders in their first two years of showing. Riders may cross enter into Beginner Ground Rails or Crossrail Hunter but not both.
- **Crossrail Hunter** is open to all ponies, horses, and riders. The course should be ridden at a consistent and safe pace.
- **HG Walk Trot Equitation Challenge** is open to young riders who are competing in Beginner classes. Riders may be asked to two-point and sit trot.
- **Jumper Classes** are open to all ponies, horses, and riders. .95 Jumper Challenge Stakes Class will be ridden Table II 2.b. Payout is 1st - 50%, 2nd - 25%, 3rd - 15%, 4th - 10%

Guidelines for Showing:

- ASTM-SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times by every rider mounted on a horse.
- Good Conduct and sportsmanship is expected from everyone attending the horse show. The Judge's decision is final.
- Schooling will be available Friday prior to the show and from 7:00 AM until start of the show.
- A fall of a rider and/or horse will result in elimination from that class. Three (3) refusals during a class will result in elimination from the class.
- It is preferred horses do not wear martingales or leg protection in the Under-Saddle classes.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a leash.

Jumper Guidelines:

Table II, Sec. 1 —The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clear rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course. 3. Time

Table II, Sec. 2 (b)—The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clear in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course. A competitor who leaves the arena after a clear round (before or after the tone) will be considered to have withdrawn from the jump-off. If there are no clear rounds and a tie exists for first place, the results will be determined by the scores and time from that round.

Table II, Sec. 2 (c)—Two Phase Competitions - The first phase to consist of 8 to 10 jumping efforts and the second phase of 5 to 7 jumping efforts. Scores are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. If a competitor has gone clear in the first phase, he will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the second phase course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line of the first phase. If there are no clear rounds and a tie exists for first place, the results will be determined by the scores and time from the first phase. The use of a Time Allowed is optional in the first phase. If a Time Allowed is not used in the first phase, then those with equal faults will remain tied.
